

**Florida State University, School of Communication  
Student Scholarship Application Instructions, Fall 2018**

**Instructions:** The School of Communication invites applications for student scholarships. Scholarships are awarded to full-time students who are majors in the Florida State University School of Communication. Qualified students may apply for multiple scholarships but, most often, will receive only one per year. It is university policy that all scholarship recipients must prepare a letter of appreciation to the donor with a copy to the department before any funds are disbursed.

**Please note: Scholarships will be awarded in September / October, and may cause an adjustment to financial aid packages. Students are responsible for consulting the Financial Services Office to determine if their awards will be affected by any additional funds.**

Applications will be accepted between **September 6, 2018** and **September 27, 2018**. Paper application packages are due in the School of Communication (University Center Building C, Suite 3100) by 5:00 pm Thursday, **September 27, 2018**. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.

One copy of the application package must be completed and can be checked to indicate consideration for multiple awards — only check awards for which you are eligible (please review qualifications carefully). You must include a statement tailored to the award(s) for which you wish to be considered. Students may be required to appear for an interview. Each application package must include:

1. A completed student information form and scholarship list indicating the scholarships requested.
2. A written statement, not exceeding two pages double-spaced, outlining why you are applying for one or more specific scholarships, your qualifications for the scholarship(s), how you intend to use the funding, and a clear indication of your financial need. Please consult the scholarship information sheet that is attached to the "Application Form."
3. An official or unofficial copy of your FSU transcript
4. A resume
5. A portfolio or video (only if required).

The application materials should be arranged in the order listed above. Incomplete packages will not be considered.

All recipients must be full-time currently enrolled undergraduate or graduate students in the Florida State University School of Communication. Successful applicants will need to complete a letter to the donors prior to fund disbursement. They will also be invited to attend the Scholarship Reception on Thursday, **November 1, 2018** to receive the scholarship award.

	<b>Bill &amp; Eloise Mills Scholarship</b> Undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need.
	<b>Bill McGrotha Scholarship</b> Undergraduate students with financial need. -Preference to students in Media/Communication Studies or major that focuses on general mass media and electronic journalism. -Preference to student with Journalism Minor with FAMU Coop Program -GPA of 3.3
	<b>Ashley Elizabeth Nugent Scholarship</b> Undergraduate students with an interest in media/communication studies, public relations and/or advertising with a 3.0 GPA or better and have financial need.

	<b>Dan St. John Internship Award</b> Supports students who have: 1) an unpaid internship with an advertising agency or public relations firm; 2) achieved junior status or higher; 3) earned a 3.0 GPA or greater; 4) have a major in advertising or public relations.
	<b>Pablo J. Lopez Memorial Scholarship</b> Undergraduate student who demonstrate financial need, 3.0 GPA or higher and interest in Hispanic Marketing Communication. <b><u>Portfolio of work required (up to 8 pages).</u></b>

#### Graduate or Undergraduate Students:

	<b>Boyle Scholarship</b> Graduate and undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need.
	<b>Emerson Climate Technologies Scholarship</b> Graduate or undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need, 3.0 GPA or higher required, pursuing certificate in Hispanic/Multicultural Marketing Communication.
	<b>Center for Hispanic Marketing Communication Advisory Board Scholarship</b> Graduate or undergraduate students actively involved in the Center for Hispanic Marketing Communication who demonstrate academic merit and financial need.
	<b>Jason Holtz Memorial Scholarship</b> Graduate or undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need.
	<b>Patricia Sibley Scholarship</b> Graduate or undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need with an interest in a career in media buying, advertising, or public relations. <b><u>Applications must include a portfolio of work.</u></b>
	<b>Steve Ellis Memorial Scholarship</b> Graduate or undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need with interest in sports information and media who have earned a 3.0 GPA or better.
	<b>C. W. Shipley Scholarship</b> Graduate or undergraduate students who have a 3.5 GPA or better and have financial need.
	<b>Fanny Lou Hamer Scholarship</b> Undergraduate or graduate student with financial need.
	<b>Laurie Hosford Scholarship in Communication</b> Undergraduate or graduate student.
